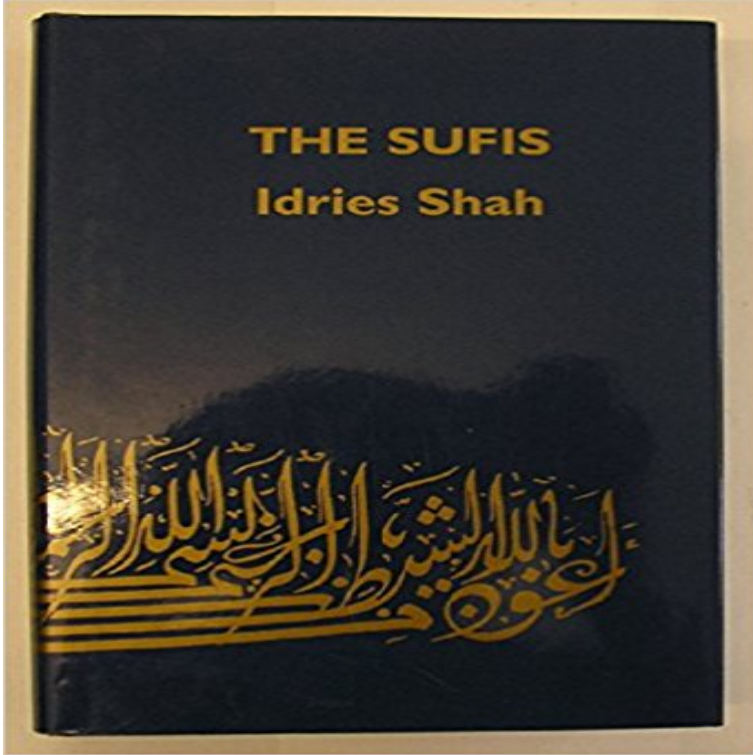


The Sufis (Jonathan Cape paperback JCP67)
