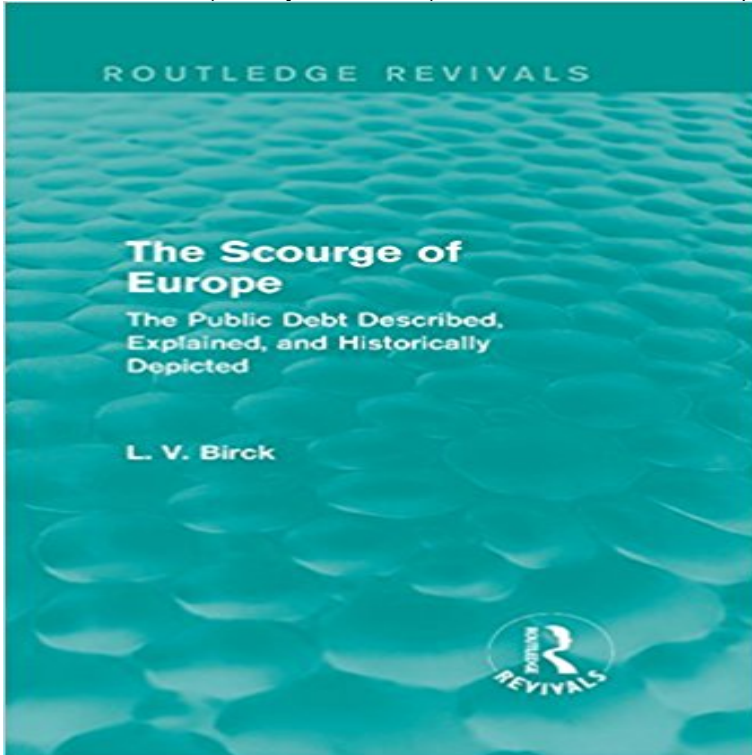


The Scourge of Europe (Routledge Revivals): The Public Debt Described, Explained, and Historically Depicted

Finally, some reflections on the policies of England, the United States, France and Germany in the latter part of the nineteenth and early-twentieth centuries are included. This book will appeal to economic and financial historians, as well as to those generally interested in European policies towards debt from the Middle Ages to modern times.
