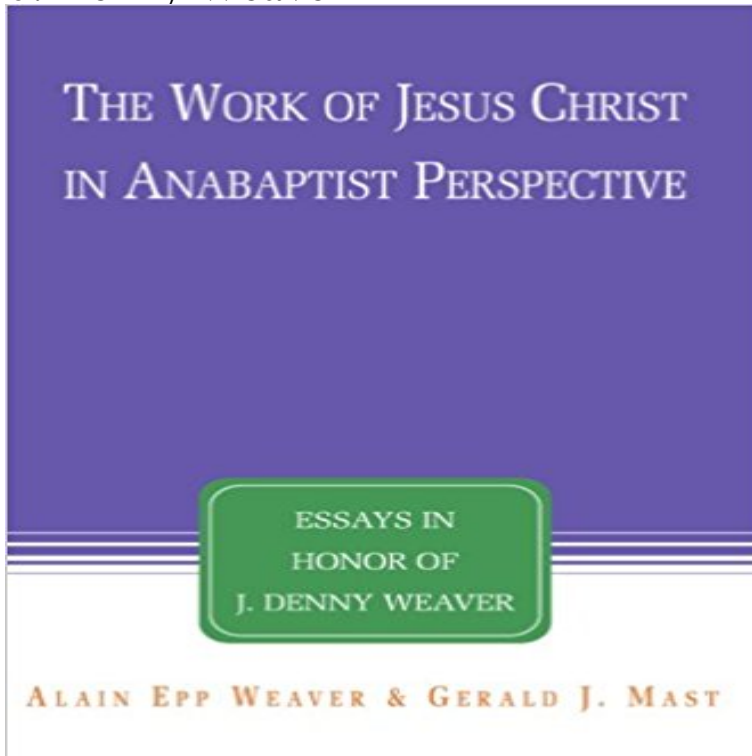


The Work of Jesus Christ in Anabaptist Perspective: Essays in Honor of J. Denny Weaver
