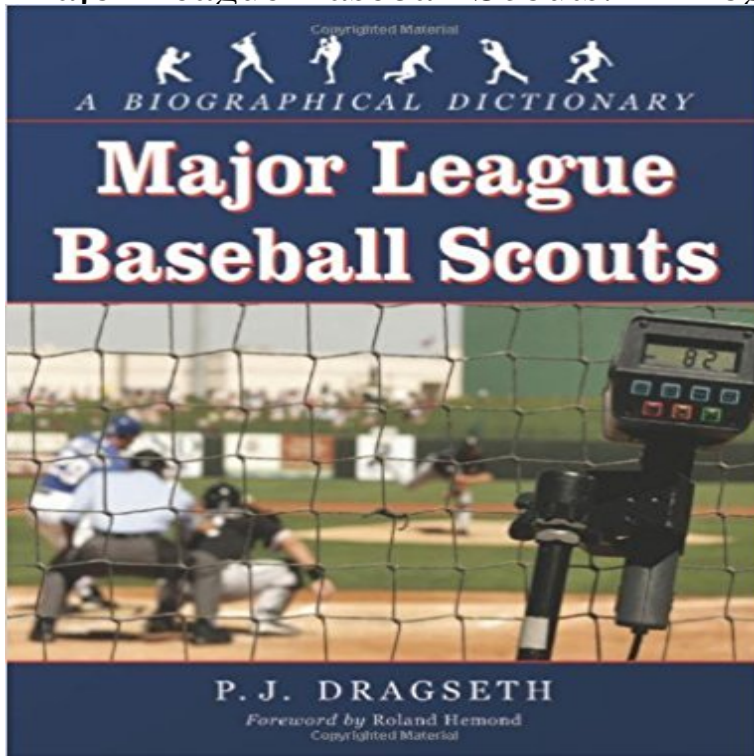


# Major League Baseball Scouts: A Biographical Dictionary
