
Walking Londons Parks and Gardens



London is as famous for its green spaces as for the historic buildings surrounding them. He includes beautiful clusters of garden squares that he has imaginatively woven into walks through central Londons most graceful districts, such as Bloomsbury and Westminster. He has set each walk in the areas historic context and included detailed information on features and highlights, such as plantings, statuary and architecture. He has also provided the reader with easy-to-follow detailed route map for each walk. Wonderfully illustrated with specially commissioned colour photographs and route maps, the book provides full details of addresses, opening times and the best bars and restaurants to visit en route.
