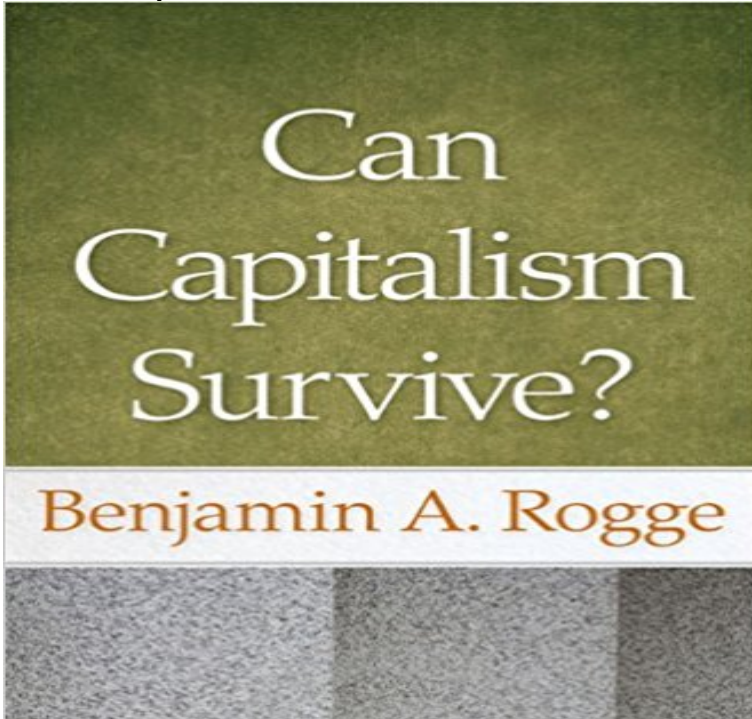


Can Capitalism Survive?
